

26th of April 2021

The first Kick-off meeting took place in virtual mode, as decided among the partners in consideration of the epidemiological emergency present in all countries. Participants from the project from Turkey, Greece, Austria, Romania and Italy had an interesting exchange of information and knowledge about the project and each person's responsibilities.

The meeting opened with the warm greeting of Mr Ummet Kaya, manager of Gölbaşı VET school who wished everyone a good job. Mr Huseyin Gokce started the first session of the meeting, presenting the project, the expected motivations and results, shared responsibilities, as described in the application form, and initiated cooperation between the partners.

Romania presented the 1st promotional video of the project on what has been achieved and what will be done in the future. The video was uploaded to the YouTube channel.
















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27th of April 2021

On the second day, the participants, after agreeing on the dates of the next meetings, followed the workshops organized by the Turkish team:

Workshop: Demonstration of a Button & LED Module Kit – Mr. Huseyin GOKCE.

Workshop: How to use ThinkerCad and Fritzing. - Mss. Goknur TABAN, Mr. Huseyin GOKCE.

During the two Workshop, thanks to the project examined, the team explained how the various partners will have to structure the different modules. Fritzing and TinkerCad were introduced, two software that allow you to simulate and draw projects with Arduino. It was decided that within the modules all circuits will have to be designed with Fritzing and it was recalled that all texts will have to be formatted in Times New Roman with font size set to 12.

The participants shared the significance and importance of this European project and finally put several questions to the Coordinator to better understand the next steps and the tasks assigned. The Italian team will draw up the Newsletter of this meeting.

We discussed the best ways to organize TPM mobility in presence and the teachers to be involved.

At the end of the second working session, the participants shared a moment of narrating their travel experiences and expressed the mutual pleasure of the time successfully spent together, important both to start a good relationship between the teachers involved and for the best success of the project.
